IMPROVING 8TH-GRADERS' UNDERSTANDING OF SOCIAL STUDIES

PROJECT TIMELINE

All teachers' class sections will be <u>randomly assigned</u> to be a part of the treatment or comparison condition.

Summer/fall 2023	 Attend a 1-day PD (exact scheduling based on school preference)
Early fall 2023	Administer pretest (one 35-minute test)Help collect student consent forms
Fall 2023	 Teach Colonial America, Road to Revolution, and American Revolution units using PACT materials Receive instructional support from UT team
Fall 2023	Audio-record your lessons daily for one unit in two class periods using a recording device provided by researchers
After teaching Colonial America	➤ Attend a 1.5-hour booster session
After teaching American Revolution	> Administer posttests (two 35-minute tests)
9 weeks after posttest	 Administer a follow-up test (one 35-minute test) 9 weeks after teaching American Revolution





RESEARCH RESPONSIBILITIES

UT Austin Staff Members

Randomly assign class sections to condition in early Fall 2023

Provide teachers with a 1-day PD and one 1.5-hour booster session

Cover the cost of substitutes so teachers can attend PD (if needed)

Provide all project materials at no cost

Provide a stipend to participating teachers

Deliver a summative report to principals describing the success of the project

Provide reimbursement or payment for data culled from Public Education Information Management System (PEIMS) database

Teachers

Attend PD

Work with researchers to distribute and collect student and parent consent forms

Deliver PACT instructional practices to some of their classes

Allow for UT personnel to provide in-class coaching

Record 8th grade social studies instruction daily for one unit in two classes (one treatment/one control) on a researcher-provided audio-recording device

Administer standardized assessments of social studies knowledge and reading comprehension to students

Complete brief surveys

District Staff Members

Allow teachers to attend PD and implement the lesson plans

Provide data from PEIMS database once at the end of the academic year
