

We are looking for students with Autism to receive tutoring from the Project READ-ASD team at The University of Texas at Austin.

WHO? Students in grades 3–8 who have Autism* in addition to

- adequate decoding skills,
- low support needs, and
- · a failing score on the state reading test or IEP reading goals

WHAT?

- Investigate a reading intervention curriculum targeting students with Autism
- Receive 50 one-on-one tutoring sessions (30 minutes each, 5 days per week)
- Receive professional development and intervention materials

WHERE?

Elementary and middle schools

WHEN?

Recruiting is ongoing with next cohort beginning in the fall of 2025.

WHY?

- · Improve reading comprehension and vocabulary outcomes and overall academic success
- Contribute to the research base about interventions to improve the academic performance of students with Autism
- Increase the motivation and reading interest of students with Autism

^{*}Students cannot meet any of the exclusionary criteria: (a) non-English proficient or English learner in a newcomer program, (b) visual impairment/blindness or hearing impairment as a disability category on their IEP, or (c) primary mode of communication other than speech (e.g., augmentative communication, sign language).
